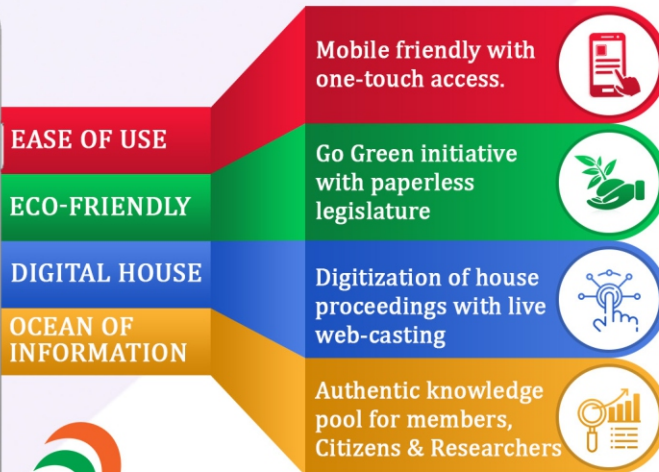

### Bihar Council

Bihar Legislative Council became the 1<sup>st</sup> legislature in the country to install infrastructure / hardware for NeVA implementation. An inauguration ceremony also took place on 25th Nov, 2021 under the guidance of Hon'ble Chairman of Bihar Legislative Council. The legislature also conducted its Winter Session - 2021 through NeVA platform.

### Nagaland Assembly

The North-eastern state of Nagaland created history by becoming the first State Assembly in the entire country to implement the NeVA programme to become completely paperless. In the Budget session of Nagaland Assembly in March 2022, the Secretariat installed devices on each table in the 60 members' Assembly.

### Uttar Pradesh Assembly

Hon'ble Speaker of Lok Sabha, Sh. Om Birla launched the NeVA on 20.05.22 for Digitisation of Uttar Pradesh Assembly in auspicious presence of Hon'ble CM, Yogi Adityanath, Hon'ble Speaker, Sh. 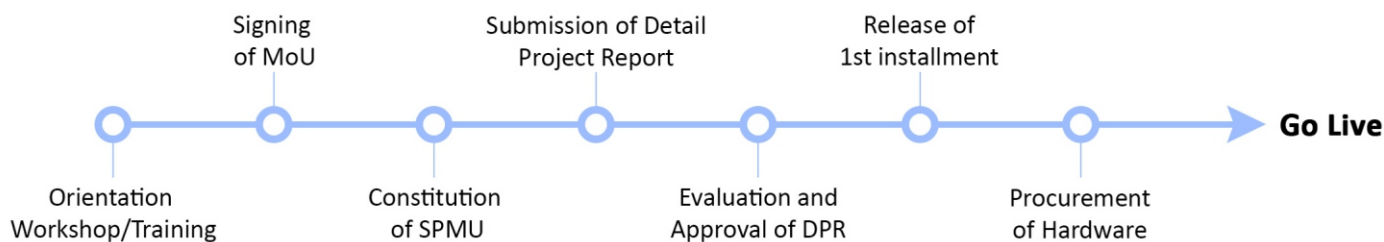

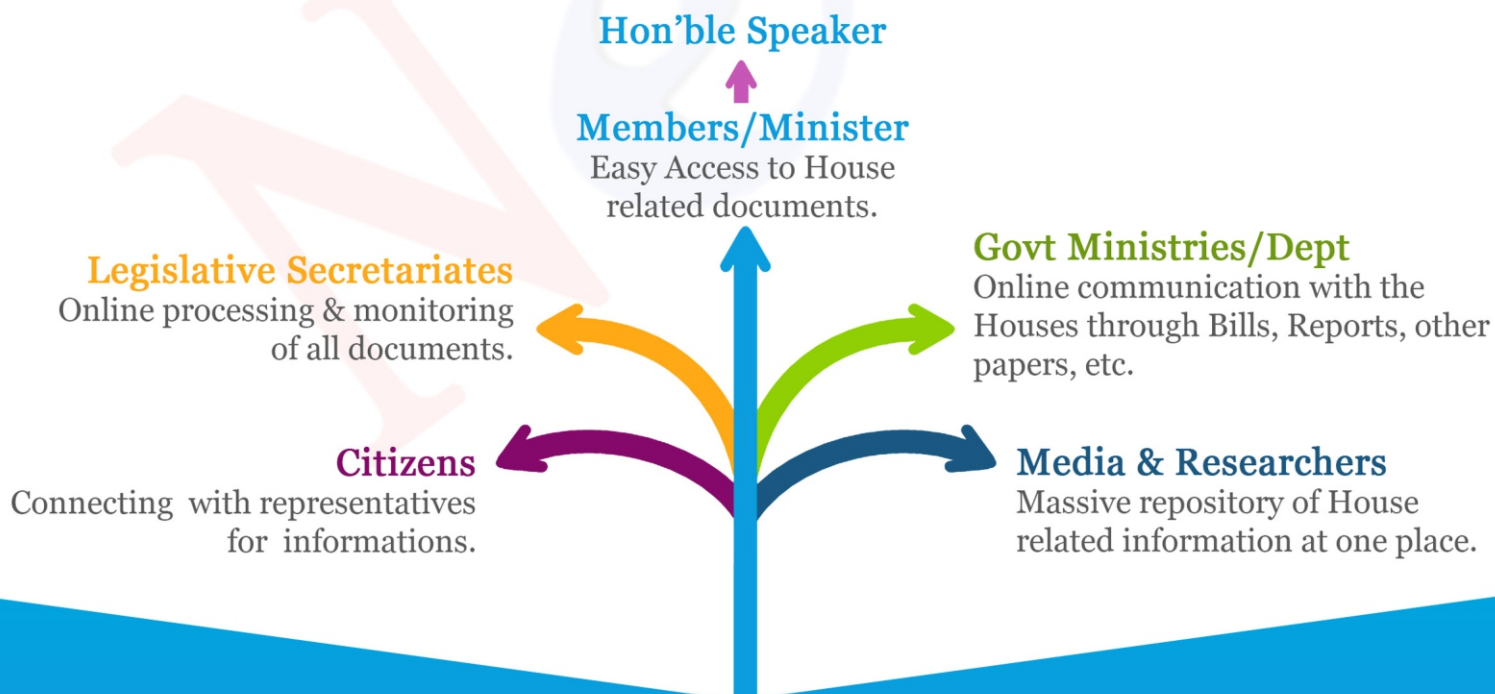
# About NeVA
